### ORDER OF SHOW – to be posted

### GENERAL RULES:

1. Senior yearlings in production must be shown as a two year old.
2. Health rules same as open class.
3. Limit of two entries in each class per exhibitor. Any leadsmen, besides the exhibitor, must be an Auglaize County junior fair exhibitor.
4. Cattle will be placed on type and graded on the combination of fitting, showing and type.
5. Signs and decorations need to be limited so as not to obstruct ventilation. Dairy department officials may ask to have problem signs and decorations removed.
6. The Grand Champion from each breed will compete for the Supreme and Reserve Champion. This animal will represent the dairy department at the Gallon of Milk Sale. The only exception will be if the Supreme Champion is at the state fair, then the Reserve Supreme Champion will represent the department.
7. Stall assignments may be changed within a club's designated area at the club advisor's discretion. Assignments may not be changed beyond the club's designated area without the prior approval of both the Junior and Senior Fair Dairy Superintendents.
8. Dairy animals may be leased. Lease papers and pictures must be on file at the Extension Office by May 15.
9. Cattle, removed from the fairgrounds, due to entry at the Ohio State Fair will be checked for participation at the state fair. If the animals are removed from the grounds and not shown at the Ohio State Fair, exhibitor will forfeit their portion of the gallon of milk sale.
10. If it is determined that the animal has lacked food and/or water, the exhibitor will not receive a fair pass the following year. This determination will be the decision of the Junior and Senior Fair Board superintendents of the department.
11. Dairy exhibits will be bedded with mulch that is provided. No dyed wood products may be used. If unacceptable products are used, the exhibitor will be given one notification by the Junior Fair Board to replace the bedding with acceptable materials. If the problem is not corrected after 24 hours, the exhibitor will be fined \$25 per day per animal.

2. Intermediate Heifer Calf, born 12/1/19 through 2/29/20.

4. Junior Yearling Heifer, born 3/1/19 through 8/31/19.
5. Senior Yearling Heifer, born 9/1/18 through 2/28/19.
6. Two Year Old Cow, born 9/1/17 through 8/31/18.

7. Three Year Old Cow, born 9/1/16 through 8/31/17.
8. Four Year Old Cow, born 9/1/15 through 8/31/16.
9. Aged Cow, 5 years old and over, born before 9/1/15.

### HOLSTEIN CLASSES:

10. Junior Heifer Calf, born on or after 3/1/20 & over 4 months of age.
11. Intermediate Heifer Calf, born 12/1/19 through 2/29/20.
12. Senior Heifer Calf, born 9/1/19 through 11/30/19.
13. Summer Yearling Heifer, born 6/1/19 through 8/31/19.
14. Spring Yearling Heifer, born 3/1/19 through 5/31/19.
15. Winter Yearling Heifer, born 12/1/18 through 2/28/19.
16. Fall Yearling Heifer, born 9/1/18 through 11/30/18.
17. Junior Two Year Old Cow, born 3/1/18 through 8/31/18.
18. Senior Two Year Old Cow, born 9/1/17 through 2/28/18.
19. Three Year Old Cow, born 9/1/16 through 8/31/17.
20. Four Year Old Cow, born 9/1/15 through 8/31/16.
21. Aged Cow, Five Years Old and Over, born before 9/1/15.

\*Some classes may be further subdivided at the fair based upon the number of entries.
