## RULES & REGULATIONS

- Competing race dogs must be a certified wiener dog. Your dog DOES NOT have to be AKA or AKC registered/certified. Please bring your dog's shot records that clearly indicate "dachshund" breed. We have the right to disqualify any dog based on questionable breed. Mix breeds are not permitted. The judges have the right to disqualify any dachshund mix breed.
- All race dogs must have a current rabies vaccine. Please bring verification with you on race day.
- You may register more than one dog. There is a \$10 pre-registration race fee per dog that must be delivered to the Auglaize Co. Ag Society by July 15th. Entry fees are non-refundable as they are used for event costs.
- Races are divided by random draw.
- Only dogs entered to race are permitted on the grounds and in the race track area.
- Only two people per dog are permitted in the race track area. One person at the start and one at the finish.
- A starting gate will be utilized and dogs will race off leash.
- Eliminations will be raced beginning at 6:00 PM on Monday, July 21, 2023 and the top dog final heat will be raced for the \$250 grand prize package on Wednesday, August 2, 2023 after the last harness race of the evening (approximately 8:30 PM).
- Dogs must display his/her best behavior. Any dog showing aggression or fighting will be asked to leave and may not be permitted to race.
- Owners must be in control of your dog at all times. Do not leave dogs unattended for any reason.
- The racecourse will be 30 yards long and dogs will race off leash.
- This is a rain or shine event.
- The ACAS reserves the right to close entries early if the maximum capacity is reached. Limited to 50 dogs.
- Entry fees do not include gate admission to the fair. You must have a valid fair pass or pay the regular admission price to enter the fairgrounds for this event.
